- b) Which of these approaches is considered most appropriate to be taken forward through the Core Strategy;
- i. Plan wide restoration strategy
- This approach is inflexible but should be taken into account.
- ii. Bespoke site specific restoration schemes
- A bespoke approach is somewhere between a top down strategic approach and a bottom up local approach.
 - There was indecision in the group as to whether it was most appropriate to start with the strategic approach and apply the local approach after or vice versa.
- iii. Mineral type/area specific strategies
- It may be most appropriate to leave a quarry site as it is.
 - For example, Portland attracts visit who come to explore the quarry sites and the geology which they expose.
- iv. Other
- The group decided that a bespoke approach was most appropriate which also took account of i) and iii).
