

TYPE OF RESTORATION	HOW ADDRESSED BY CORE STRATEGY
<p>This may concentrate on one specific element e.g.:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Landscape led - Recreation led - Forestry led - Development led - Habitat led 	<p>These approaches were thought of as a top down Strategy lead approaches which would perhaps in reality respect a far too rigid approach and might not take account of what would be most appropriate from a local perspective.</p> <p>For example, the landscape character strategy may suggest one broad use, where as locally this may not be the most appropriate restoration.</p>
<p>Multi-purpose restoration</p>	<p>The most appropriate restoration may be more than one use.</p>
<p>Site specific – each site is treated on its own merits</p>	<p>An open minded approach should be adopted, taking account of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - What is being lost - What the local public want e.g. access rights - What the County requires e.g. biodiversity - What the landlord wants <p>This should ensure that the most appropriate use is restored onto the site. Joined up thinking with other strategies will take account of the various uses appropriate on the site.</p>
